**EASIEST WAY GOING PEAK TO PEAK**

**Peak 7:**  
Take the Independence SuperChair™ down at 3:45pm. Each Peak 7 via Chairlift™ to the summit from the bottom of Peak 7 to Peak 8, except via the Independence SuperChair™.

**Peak 8 to Peak 9:**  
Follow Columbia to Pioneer, take Pioneer to the Independence SuperChair™.

**Peak 8 to Peak 9:**  
From the top of S-Chair follow Four O'Clock to Summit to the base of Peak 9.  
From the Vista House follow Springwater to Four O'Clock to Summit to the base of Peak 9.  
From the Vista House follow Freddy's Freeway to S-Chair to Peak 9 Summit.

**Peak 9 to Peak 10:**  
Follow River to Collier and lower Country Bay to the base of the Falcon SuperChair™.

**Peak 10 to Peak 9:**  
From the base of the Falcon SuperChair™ follow Red Rover to the Beaver Run SuperChair™.

**Peaks 9 and 10 to Peak 8:**  
Follow Bonanza to Lower Sandown and take the Peak 8 SuperConnect™.  
Follow Red Rover to Lower Sandown and take the Peak 8 SuperConnect™.  
Follow Upper Peak 8 Transfer to the Peak 8 SuperConnect™ Midway Load.
